

### **Meeting Notes**

Current SAL account balance is \$4,061. Members discussed giving \$500 each to the spring and fall "Honor Flights".

We have 55 paid members and, although we are way over 100%, we still have 9 unpaid members that we are carrying on the books. At end of April, those who have not paid will be removed from the rooster. The Squadron welcomed Larry Waskiewitz as our newest member.

It was suggested that everyone should be able to get a list of members and their contact information. Paul is going to check to see if that including email addresses can be obtained from the master list. This would also be helpful so information besides newsletters can be easily distributed to our members.

The group approved \$1,500 to be spent to create a Memorial Day display for our fallen veterans along the river at Veteran's Park. About \$1,200 will be needed for printing each veteran's name on a banner, while the remainder will go towards purchasing 2'x3' flags. We already planned to purchase a large flag for \$360.

SAL still needs 6-8 volunteers to help with clean-up and season preparation of our Camp American Legion cabin during April 20 - 26. Blinds and furniture need to be installed and leaves and tree limbs need to be cleaned up. About four to five members are planning to go on the morning of Thursday, April 23 and return at noon on Saturday, April 25.
