The American Legion membership year is the calendar year - from January 1st to December 31st. But, just like a prescription to a magazine, they want you to renew your the subscription before it runs out. So, you probably have started to receive notices to send in your \$40.00 for the membership year 2026 already.

Where does that \$40.00 go?

Well, the Post only gets to keep \$5.00 out of it to help cover our expenses.

Then, according to our American Legion, Wisconsin Constitution and By-Laws;

SECTION 3. A member in good standing in the Department of Wisconsin is one for whom their Post has remitted, with their membership card, their \$23.50 for National dues and \$11.50 for Department dues. The Department dues shall be earmarked as follows:

General Operation Fund ----- \$11.15

Dues Investment Fund ----- .35

SECTION 4. There is hereby created a separate fund entitled Rehabilitation Fund. Money from the Rehabilitation Fund can only be used to support the fiscal requirements of the Department Service Office, Camp American Legion and the Veterans Hospital Fund.


Veteran / Active Military + 3 Family Members Sunday August 3rd Free Admission 10am-4pm
