

#### CAMP AMERICAN LEGION REPORT The 2nd District's Fall Conference

500 applications were received. 350 Veterans attended. 300 dependents & care givers, for a total of 730 participants (not including program staff and volunteers).

#### Completed Projects;

Higley Hall *Century Wall Project*. The hall has all new walls, (pine wood) around windows, wainscoting and 2 completely remodeled bathrooms.

The fire pit has been redone. The area has been leveled and cement poured to enlarge the whole area. A special design was inlaid with a 4-foot pit in the center. This project was fully funded by a donor.

The ramp going into the main entrance of the lodge has been totally removed and a new concrete ramp and railing were installed. This project was by the same donor as the fire pit.

#### **Future Projects;**

Cabin 18 is in very, very bad shape. We have no sponsor for this cabin. The building has been vacant for 2 camp seasons. It will be demolished. The plan is to tear down, and put a pavilion in the thumb print. It is perfect for a quiet space, meeting space, etc. There is also a nice beach area on Lake Carr in front of cabin 18 and 17 (Post 355).

Storage Building 50x100 with a cost \$200,000. We desperately need a large storage building for winter storage of our 7 or 8 pontoon boats and other equipment. The building would be by the rental cabins across the road on Bird Road. We still need donations for this project.

Circular stairs on east side of the main lodge are unusual steps and very dangerous. They are round sort of steps and many people have fallen and tripped due to the unusual construction. We need to lay concrete with a railing.

#### On our wish list - 2 Kayaks.

Our wheelchair veterans enjoy siting in the kayaks and paddling around the lake.

An approximate cost per kayak is \$1,400.00.
